

53rd Annual Grand Junction Dolphin Invitational Swim Meet

Friday, Saturday and Sunday, June 22-24, 2007

SANCTION: Held under the sanction of USA Swimming, Inc. Sanction #:

MEET: Age Group Timed Final Meet

LOCATION: Lincoln Park Moyer Pool, Grand Junction, CO; 970-254-3887. Bounded by corners of North Ave. and 12th St, and Gunnison St. Home of the 1999 USA Western Zone Championship and 2002, 2005 and 2007 LC State Championships!

FACILITY: 8 Lane, 50-Meter, Outdoor Pool, limited warm-up and cool-down area (6 lane shallow), will be available at all times.

SCHEDULE:

Friday Afternoon:	Warm-up: 3:00 p.m.; Start: 4:00 p.m.
Saturday Morning:	Warm-up: 8:00 a.m.; Start: 9:00 a.m.
Afternoon:	Warm-up: Immediately following the morning session but not before 1:00 p.m.; Start 1 hour later
Sunday Morning:	Warm-up: 8:00 a.m.; Start: 9:00 a.m.
Afternoon:	Warm-up: Immediately following the morning session but not before 1:00 p.m.; Start: 1 hour later

TIMING: Colorado Timing System with touch pads, back-up buttons and electronic scoreboard. HyTek Meet Manager software will be used.

RULES: Current USA rules will govern the meet. Events will be swum in the long course configuration: 50 meters X 8 lanes. No exhibition swimming allowed. All events are timed finals. All entries must include times. For swimmers without competition times, coaches may submit times that the coach reasonably believes that the swimmer can achieve in competition. Submit long course meter times only.

The meet will be pre-seeded except for the distance events: 1 through 6 which will require a positive check-in 30 minutes prior to the start of the session. Distance events will be swim fastest to slowest, alternating boys and girls. Distance events will be limited to the top 24 boys and girls. Teams will be notified by Monday, June 18, 2007, and those entry fees refunded. Swimmers must provide their own timers and counters for the distance events. There will be a courtesy time standard of 16 minutes for the 800 Free.

Colorado Swimming, Inc. warm-up procedures will be observed. **THREE POINT ENTRY** will be strictly enforced. Failure to comply may result in a fine and disqualification from participation.

Declaration of relays and scratches 30 minutes prior to each session is required.

The meet referee will have the final authority on all procedures regarding the conduct of the meet. The referee may combine individual events by age, sex, and/or distance. All coaches and uniformed officials must display their USA/CSI cards when on deck. Current certification is mandatory. Coaches that are in non-compliance will not be allowed on deck.

Warm-up and start times may vary. We may condense the format to make most expeditious possible use of time, but the ages of the sessions will not change. Please include a valid email address to notify teams of changes.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all swimmers holding a 2006/2007 USA Swimming Membership card. Any swimmer that appears on the CSI exceptions report without registration must come to the meet prepared to show their card, or they will be deck registered before they can enter the water. A surcharge for deck registration will also apply: \$27.00 year round and \$14.00 for seasonal, plus the normal registration fee. Unattached swimmers are also eligible, but may not swim

on relays. Previously entered athletes that have met eligibility requirements may request entry in additional events with the availability of an empty lane and at the discretion of the Meet Director. Requests must be made 30 minutes prior to the start of each session. No events will be reseeded due to deck entries and no athlete meet registrations will be accepted on deck except for relay only athletes. Age as of Friday, June 22, 2007 will govern entries.

ENTRIES: All swimmers may swim 4 individual events per day, and 1 relay.

ENTRY FEES:

Swimmer Surcharge	\$ 7.00 per swimmer

CO Western Slope League receives \$.15 and Colorado Swimming \$.50 of each individual event.

ENTRY LIMIT: Due to the number of swimmers expected, the meet will be limited to approximately the first 2100 individual splashes received. Teams, however will not be split up (this pertains only to entries received at the same time while still under the cap of 2100 splashes). Once the splash limit is reached, no additional entries will be accepted. This includes additional entries from teams already participating in the meet.

ENTRY DEADLINE: Entries must be received by 6:00 p.m, Friday, June 15, 2007. No late entries will be accepted. Please note that if we reach our splash limit the entries will be closed, even if this occurs before the entry deadline.

DECK ENTRIES: Deck entries will be accepted only for open lanes. No new heats will be created. You may deck enter for the current session beginning at the start of warm-up. Deck entries will close 30 minutes before the start of each session. You may deck enter the future sessions' events after deck entries close for the current session.

The deck entry fee is \$7.00 per event. Relay deck entry fees are \$10.00 per relay. Swimmers not previously entered in the meet must present their USA swimming registration card at Clerk of Course to be able to deck enter.

ENTRY PROCEDURE: E-mail entries are preferred.

Times for all events should be submitted in long course meters. A current Colorado Swimming Meet Verification Form must accompany all entries.

Email Entries: Email entries to Carrie Walton at cwalton41@bresnan.net. Attach a Word document of the Hy-Tek Team Manager Meet Entry Report by swimmer. If you don't receive an email confirmation then your entries were not received. Confirmed e-mailed entries will not need to send the diskette or Entry Reports. Checks and Meet Verification must be postmarked by Friday, June 15, 2007.

Mail Entries: Include a Team Manager report of meet entries by swimmer, along with the diskette/CD, Meet Verification Form and payment. Mailed entries are to be delivered by 6:00 p.m. June 15, 2007.

Other entries must be on CSI duplicate pink or blue master sheets (2 copies) with swimmer's name, USA number, age, event number and entry time in long course meters or "NT". AN ADDITIONAL FEE OF \$1.00 PER INDIVIDUAL EVENT WILL BE CHARGED FOR ENTRIES SUBMITTED IN THIS MANNER.

All entries must be sent to the entry chairman. If sending overnight mail, please **waive the signature**. DO NOT SEND ENTRIES TO THE POOL.

AWARDS: Individual Events: 12 and under will receive medals for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places. Ribbons will be awarded for 4th through 8th place. There will be heat awards for 12&U events.

Relays: Relays will receive ribbons for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.

High Point: Individual high point awards will be awarded to the top female and male individual in the following age categories: 10&Under, 11-12, 13-14, 15 & over.

SCORING: Individual: 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1
Relays: 40-34-32-30-28-26-24-22-18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2
Note: All events will be functionally seeded by time. They will be broken into the following age groups for scoring purposes: 10&Under, 11-12, 13-14, 15&Over.

RESULTS: Results (full Meet Manager backup and Team Manager results) will be emailed within 5 days. If time and equipment permit, results may be available at the end of the meet on diskette (Bring your own formatted diskette). No paper copies of results will be generated unless asked for by a coach.

SEATING and SHADE:
Seating and shade are limited. We recommend that you bring your own deck chair. All tents must be placed in the park on the west side of the pool. No tent stakes longer than 4 inches may be used, and no tents with floors may be located on the grass. You may pitch and leave a tent overnight at your own risk. **No tents may be located on the lawn of the Parks and Recreation office on Thursday or Friday, and no tents will be permitted in the park to the east of the pool or in the water slide area. No overnight tent camping in park.**

CONCESSIONS / HOSPITALITY:
Swimwear, t-shirts, food and drinks will be available. The Orchard Mesa Lions Club will provide breakfast on Saturday and Sunday.
